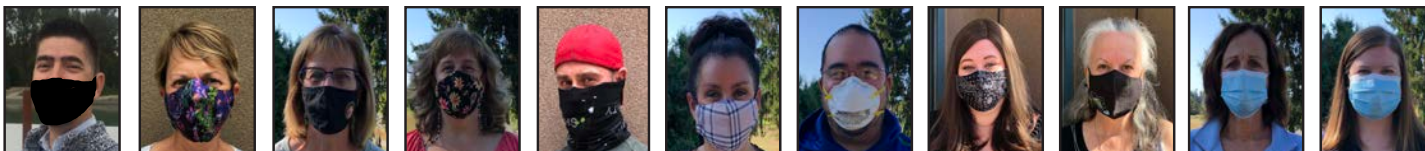

LTA French Educator Committee



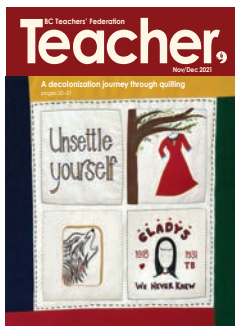
