SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT -

BETWEEN:

BC Public School Employers' Association / School District No. 35 (Langley)

(the "Employer")

AND!

BC Teachers' Federation / Langley Teachers' Association

(the "Union")

GENERAL - RESOURCE TEACHER CASELOADS

BCTF File No. 35-2020-00012 (Local File No. 35-19-04) and Local File No. 35-20-07

WHEREAS:

- A. The Union filed grievance numbers 35-19-04 (BCTF File No. 35-2020-0002) and 35-20-07, relating to the caseload of Resource teachers (the "Grievances").
- B. The Parties agree to fully and finally resolve these grievances on the following terms:
 - 1. The Employer will provide information similar to the attached February 2021 spreadsheet to the LTA for March, April, May and June 2021 and will answer reasonable clarifying questions concerning the information.

- 2. In order to address non-compliance during the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 school years, subject to Ministry funding, the Employer will provide \$450,000.00 to the LTA to provide the remedies set out below to Resource teachers who had caseloads in excess of those under the collective agreement. Affected teachers may select from the following remedies:
 - a. Funding for professional development for the affected teacher, to be used in non-instructional periods; and
 - b. Funding for resources selected by the affected teacher for that teacher's use; and
 - c. Other remedies that the local parties agree would be appropriate.

3. Commencing for the 2021/2022 school year:

- a. In order to secure funding for additional Resource teachers, the District will incorporate into its Resource teacher staffing budgeting process an increase in the projection of designated students which is based on the percentage increase of the previous Ministry verified September 30th 1701 data over the Ministry verified September 30th 1701 data from the year prior to that.
- b. The Parties acknowledge that caseloads change throughout the year and that a balance needs to be struck between managing caseloads and continuity of support to students and stability of caseloads for resource teachers. As a result, caseloads will be monitored monthly and will be brought into compliance quarterly either through redeployment of central resource teachers, deployment of additional Resource teachers or, if no Resource teachers are available, the addition of Learning Assistance or other teachers to assist Resource teachers with their caseload.
- c. The Employer will continue to make all reasonable efforts to hire sufficient resource teachers to meet caseload limits.
- d. Where caseload limits are exceeded, the Employer will provide the Union with monthly reports showing the caseloads of affected teachers.

4,	The Partles' prior agreement with respect to resource caseloads, reached as resolution to
	prievances over 2017-2018 and 2018-2019, continues to be effective.

- 5. This Settlement Agreement is without prejudice or precedent to the position of the parties on any other matters in this district and on any matters in any other districts.
- 6. This agreement is conditional on the Employer obtaining Ministry funding. If funding is secured, the Grievances are resolved. If funding is not secured, the Union may proceed with the Grievances.
- 7. Arbitrator Marguerite Jackson, Q.C., will retain jurisdiction over the interpretation and application of this agreement.
- 8. This agreement is effective upon signing by all parties:
