Subject: Personal Leave and TTOCing

Hello, Tanya

As discussed, with the increased demand for TTOC's due to COVID, the Board will begin allowing teachers on a partial Personal Leave of Absence to TTOC anywhere in the District on the days that they are not scheduled to work their regular assignment. This temporary one-time measure will be in place until June 30, 2022 and is only available to teachers on a partial Personal Leave. Teachers on partial Personal Leave will receive a form from H asking them if they want to be reinstated as a TTOC on the days they are available for work. Once they submit their decision to TTOC and are reactivated, AMS will begin calling them out and they will be able to pick up dispatches on the work board.

The Board will, without prejudice and precedent, allow teachers on a partial Personal Leave to TTOC in the District from January 17, 2022 to June 30, 2022. This decision cannot be brought forward in the future as an example of past practice nor be used in any future grievance or arbitration.

I look forward to the union's acknowledgement that this extraordinary decision is without prejudice and precedent.
