BCTF Group RRSP

One of the benefits of being a BCTF member is the ability to contribute to a group RRSP. All BCTF members have access to group RRSPs. BCTF Group RRSPs have four distinct advantages. First, they allow contributions at source, which is a convenient way to invest. Second, no tax is paid on the monies invested, so there is no waiting period for getting the tax deduction.

Third, funds invested earn interest through the year. Finally, the plans available to members offer both a variety of investment options and some funds not regularly available.

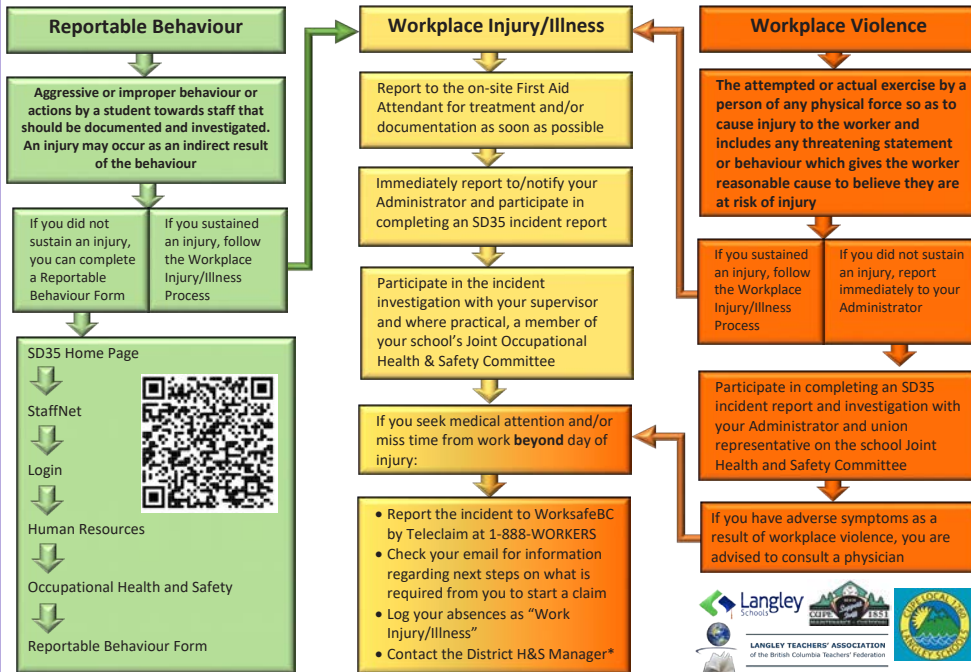
