'Role & Function of the Social Justice Rep'

School-based social justice representatives working with the local's Social Justice Committee can explore their roles and the functions they have within the school and local. They will have an opportunity to set out long- and short-term plans and explore how to work in coalition with others in their schools and community.

'How to be an Antiracist'

This skills-based workshop is a powerful, practical way to promote awareness and empathy, and to develop the skills to effectively respond to discriminatory remarks and incidents of racism. Although it is often easy to identify an incident of personal racism, responding effectively is often challenging. This workshop has been updated to provide participants with opportunities to practise strategies to intervene effectively.

Registration Deadline: April 12, 2023. TTOC's must be booked ASAP. If you leave it too long you run the risk of being declined a TTOC and/or being asked to return to your classroom.

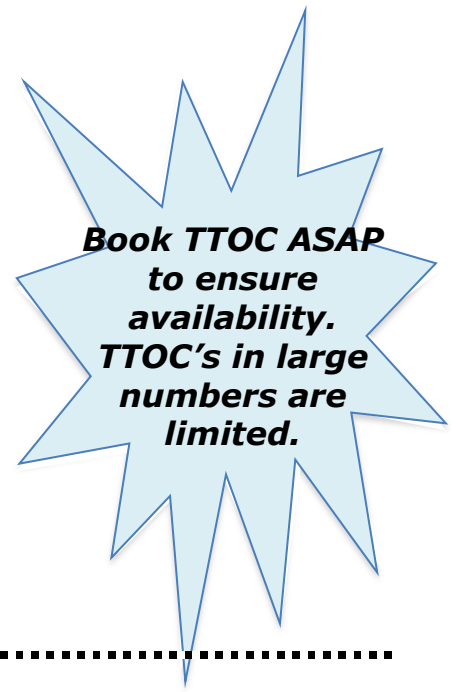
