



Langley Teachers' Association Q Audit Settlement Funds Application Form

The LTA Executive Committee recently approved the recommendation from the Q-Audit committee to open access to the remaining Q-Audit settlement funds.

In recognition that certain members, including but not limited to primary educators, adult educators, distance educators, and alternate educators, have not had equitable access to remedy supports, funds will be made available to individuals who:

- *have previously received less than \$2000 in remedy or settlement funds*
 - *worked as a classroom teacher in the 2019-20, 2020-21 and/or 2021-22 school years*
- and
- *currently work in a classroom setting (classroom teachers or non-enrolling teachers who provide student support within a full class setting)*

Eligible teachers will receive a sum of \$1700, which will be made available through the District Remedy Tracker App and can be used for the purchase of classroom resources (including technology and furniture) in accordance with the Local Remedy Agreement. Members can apply until May 30, 2026 using the form below.
